

HANDRAIL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Estimated Assembly Time: 30 Minutes with 1/2' Allen wrench
- All Bluff Yard Ramps come with handrail post base plates welded in place. (See illustration)
- All base plates already have the required hardware installed in each one. (Hardware not shown)
- All necessary handrail posts and rails will be packaged within the ramp. These come ready to assemble.
- Remove the existing hardware from the base plate on the ramp, using one of the provided posts; place its base plate on top of the ramp base plates, being sure to line holes up for installing hardware.
- Install hardware and tighten equally on both sides. (See illustration; hardware partially shown)
- Once all posts are installed, you can then install the rails.
- Each rail fits between (2) posts and will have an upper and lower rail. They rest in the pocket without the use of hardware for easy removal.

ASSEMBLING THE LEVEL OFF SECTION

- **Please Note**: The rails for the level off section (at the top closest to the truck) are different lengths.
- The longer rail will be the upper, and the shorter will be the lower.

This completes your installation process.
